Seek parents'/ carers' views on:

1. How happy and safe their child is at school
2. How well the school communicates with them, asks for their views and addresses any concerns that they have
3. The effectiveness of teaching and the progress their child makes
4. How well the school uses homework to extend their child's learning
5. How well the school keeps parents informed about the progress their child is making
6. The range of the curriculum offer, for example opportunities to be creative or to develop physical skills
7. How effectively the school encourages positive attitudes to learning, such as self-assessment, collaboration and perseverance
8. The part parents/carers and the community play in the life of the school
9. The support and guidance available to pupils, for example those with special needs
10. The extent to which the school promotes its safeguarding culture, including how well it promotes equality, diversity, anti-bullying and respect for others
11. Other issues identified by the lead inspector e.g., from the analysis of the parent/carers and pupil questionnaires
